

## Funding Opportunities May 31, 2022

National Alliance for Water Innovation, Department of Energy NAWI Pilot Program Request for Proposals | Concept Paper Due: June 29, 2022

**Summary:** The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), in partnership with the National Alliance for Water Innovation (NAWI), announced a \$5 million solicitation for small-scale desalination and water-reuse technologies that will improve the safety, security, and affordability of America's water supply.

The Pilot Program RFP is seeking proposals from teams to design, build, test, and/or operate small-scale desalination/water reuse treatment systems that treat a "non-traditional" or impaired (and presently economically unusable) water to standards necessary for an identified beneficial use.

The overarching goal of this Pilot Program is to field and operate a set of water treatment systems in realistic operating environments to accelerate the development of commercial, small-scale treatment systems that can produce water at pipe-parity from various non-traditional water sources.

Estimated Number of Awards: Between 4 and 8 awards

Funding Amount: Up to \$5,000,000 federal funds with a minimum of 35% cost-share for

each project
